

## About Us

Learn to Skate Cincinnati offers a variety of programming. Classes for all ages and abilities are offered in recreational and competitive skating as well as beginning skating for hockey. We use the Skate with US program designed by United States Figure Skating to aid in learning and skating enjoyment. Come join the fun!!

## What's Included with the LTS ?

- ◆ Lessons this session will be conducted over a 7 week period.
- ◆ Class sizes are 3-6 students per instructor for Snow-pow Sam classes; 5-12 students per instructor for Basic 1-Freeskate 6.
- ◆ Skaters are tested during the last class to determine skill mastery and progression to the next level. Certificates are awarded to all skaters. Patches will be given to all skaters who pass their skating level.

## What do I wear?

- ◆ Single-blade hockey or figure skates.
- ◆ *Note:* Both hockey and figure skates are available for rental during lessons for \$2 (with a 7 week for \$14 pass).
- ◆ Comfortable, flexible warm clothing. Dress in layers. Mittens or gloves recommended.
- ◆ Children 5 and under are required to wear a helmet. Bicycle helmets are permitted.

## Policies

- ◆ A \$30 fee is assessed on all returned checks.
- ◆ Refunds: 100% before registration deadline, 75% after the first week 50% after the second week of classes. No refund after third class.
- ◆ Class Cancellations: We reserve the right to cancel an individual class because of a rink conflict. In such a case, a make-up class will be scheduled.
- ◆ Confirmations: No confirmation calls will be made or letters sent. For on-line registrations your credit card confirmation is a class confirmation.
- ◆ Make-ups—There are no make-ups
- ◆ Class Size: In order to hold a class, there must be a minimum of 3 skaters. If this minimum is not met, we have the right to combine levels or cancel the class.

## COST—7 week class

- \* Cost for 25 minute, 7 wk LTS classes is \$105
- \* Cost for 50 minute, 7 wk classes \$135
- \* Cost for 25 minute, 4 wk Girl/Boy Scout Class \$30
- ◆ Sign up for classes at the registration table in front of one of the ice rinks on the last day of the current session for a \$10 discount. You can also register for classes on line on the dates listed on the opposite side of this brochure for a \$10 discount.

- ◆ Registrations will be accepted the first day of class based on availability. Registrations will be taken through the second week of the session based on availability. Classes will not be pro-rated.
- ◆ New skaters will receive a USFS Booklet to track their skills and aid in the practice time at time of registration.
- ◆ Classes may close before the first day of class. Do not call for availability. Any class still listed on-line is still open to registrations. We continue to make additional classes as needed until the on-line registration date.

## Learn to Skate

We offer Learn to Skate classes for kids starting at age 3 though adults. The beginning classes for age 3-5 is called Snowplow Sam 1, ages 6-14 called Basic 1, and 14 and up is Adult 1. These classes are 25 minutes in length. Once the skaters reach Basic 3 or Hockey 1 classes move to 50 minutes in length. See our web site of the current session insert or on-line for specific skills at each level and time and day offerings. We offer classes thru Free Skating (jumps & spins).

## Tiny Tots & Home School

Our Monday afternoon groups are specially geared toward Home School skaters and kids ages 3-6yrs old. If a Mother's/Father's group have enough members to have their own class we may also be able to schedule an alternative day for our just for your group. Home School—We would love to help you fill your physical education requirement in a fun and unique way. If a home school association would like to have an outing lessons, party etc.. ## Learn to Play Hockey

All hockey players must first learn how to skate. Players age 3-5 will progress from Snowplow Sam 1-3 before Hockey 1 while 6-14 year olds need to pass Basic 1 before beginning Hockey 1. Hockey 2-5 is a joint program with LTS Cincinnati and the Queen City Hockey Association. This is when the kids wear equipment and learn to pass, shoot etc.. Practice is held for 75 minutes (includes skating, drills, and a scrimmage) on Sunday and there is an option to play an additional game weekly. Equipment may also be rented (\$25/first 7 wks—\$10/session after that) instead of purchasing all the gear. Contact Carl Robinson at \_\_\_\_\_ to schedule a time to rent equipment.
